If you stop part way on any of the

- No jewellery, loose items or sharp objects
- Young children who wear nappies must wear an aqua-nappy, they are available on-site
- Only swimwear may be worn on the slides and play structure
- No swimwear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets or metal ornamentation

- slides, remain in the seated position and push yourself to the exit
- Each rider is to immediately leave the waterslide on discharge from the flume
- Under no circumstances should any guest slide under the influence of alcohol
- The play structure must be evacuated if at risk of lightning storm
