

STUDENT SUPERVISION

At Outback Splash we are committed to the safety of each and every one of our Guests thus it is a requirement that each student group is closely monitored by a member of your supervisory team. To facilitate the close supervision of your students we offer FREE entry to Teachers / Supervisors at the specified ratios. Please also note that all water-based attractions and activities are attended by our trained Ride Attendants and Lifeguards who hold all relevant formal qualifications as a minimum standard.

1 Adult Supervisor to 6 Students.

Students Grades 4-6

1 Adult Supervisor to 8 Students

Students Grades 7-12

1 Adult Supervisor to 10 Students

Any additional supervisors who attend on the day are charged a \$14.00 entry fee. Additional supervisors are permitted for students with disabilities.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. Can we bring our own lunch/cook a BBQ?

Yes you can! School groups are more than welcome to bring a packed lunch. Students are also more than welcome to purchase food and beverage items from our outlets on the day.

2. What can we wear down the slides?

Bathers are the preferred choice of swimwear, but Guests are also permitted to ride in simple cotton shorts, sports shorts, wetsuits, leggings, simple t-shirts including long sleeves, singlets, and rash shirts.

For safety reasons we do not allow Guests to ride the slides wearing denim, tops or shorts with embellishments (including zips, studs, diamantes, buttons etc.), cargo shorts, track pants or thick jumpers.

3. Can the students purchase food and drinks from the food outlets?

Yes, students are more than welcome to purchase food, snacks, ice creams and lollies from our food or other outlets as they please.

4. Can students use their season pass to gain entry?

Yes, students can of course use their current season passes for entry. Please let us know prior to your arrival how many students will be using their season passes. Students will need to bring their season passes with them on the day as they will need to be scanned on entry.

5. Can we just do the dry activities?

Yes, here at Outback Splash we offer an A-Maze-ing Play Excursion option, including just our non-water-based attractions and activities. This can be selected as an option during the booking process.

6. Are the water attractions fenced off from the dry area of the park?

The water attractions are not fenced off from the dry attractions, however, they are located in a separate area of the park.

7. What is the maximum depth of your water attractions?

The current maximum depth of water attractions here at Outback Splash is 30cm (300mm) which according to the Department of Education excursion policy does not qualify it as a 'closed water body', meaning you should not need to provide any additional supervision other that the lifeguards we have here on-site. Some schools' policies may differ – so please be sure to check your individual school policy.

8. Do you have qualified lifeguards supervising the water attractions?

Yes, we have Royal Life Saving qualified lifeguards on-site supervising our attractions as required by the relevant laws and required ratios. All our slides are also attended by trained ride attendants.

9. How many lifeguards are stationed at the wet attractions?

A minimum of two qualified lifeguards are present on-site at the water bodies at all times, with other Team members being trained ride attendants. All Team members have training in crisis and emergency management should any situation arise.

10. Who responds to First Aid and Incidents?

Each day we have key leadership Team members on site dedicated to responding to incidents should they occur, including a First Aid Officer. Our Team members are First Aid trained as per national standards, with advanced resuscitation training also. Team members are also trained across a variety of scenarios that could occur in the Park, including major first aid incidents, alongside park evacuation, fire training, wildlife awareness etc. We have a generously stocked First Aid room on-site, including a defibrillator and epi-pens, so we are prepared for any situation that may arise. We have a number of policies and procedures in place for in-park incidents, in brief; once the incident has been brought to our attention, they are assessed by the First Aid Officer, who will then alert the Duty Manager for the appropriate course of action. For First Aid incidents involving Guests who require immediate treatment, such as broken bones or unconsciousness – an ambulance would be called. More general incidents such as bumps and scraps are taken care of by our First Aid team.

11. In the event of calling an ambulance - who do you use?

In the event of requiring an ambulance, 000 is called and the Ambulance services dispatched is at their discretion – in WA 000 calls are looked after by St John Ambulance. We don't call hospitals directly – only 000.

The nearest hospital emergency rooms are Joondalup Hospital being approximately 20 minutes away, and Midland Hospital which is approximately 27 minutes away. Response time for an ambulance is generally dependent on what priority the incident is determined by the call centre when 000 is called, and what ambulances are close by. In the event of an incident requiring non-urgent medical treatment, the nearest medical centres are Bullsbrook Medical Centre located at 49 Kimberly St, Bullsbrook which is around 8 minutes away, as well as Banksia Grove Family Practice located at Shop 11, 1001 Joondalup Drive, Banksia Grove, which is around 13 minutes away.
