## ACCESSIBILITY GUIDELINES

#### ACCESS CATEGORY TYPES

The banding of the below access categories has been developed to assist in ensuring guests can make an educated and informed decision about which attractions they are able to experience.

#### ACCESS CATEGORY 1:

Attractions in this category have full wheelchair access with no steps or stairways and are level surfaces. Access and egress to this attraction is available without specific companion assistance. There are also no physically limiting rider requirements stipulated by Outback Splash, or the Manufacturer of the attraction that cannot be overcome by companion assistance.

#### Attractions in this category are:

- Giant Chess
- Hookey
- Koala Experience
- Octopus Bay area
- Splash Island Splash Deck

#### ACCESS CATEGORY 2:

Attractions in this category have limited wheelchair access with some steps or stairways and are multi-level surfaces. Access and egress to this attraction may require specific companion assistance. There are also some physically limiting rider requirements stipulated by Outback Splash, or the Manufacturer of the attraction that cannot be overcome by companion assistance.

- Children's Playground
- Danae's Dilemma
- Hedge Maze
- Mini Golf
- Octopus Bay Slides and pool
- Phil's Frustration
- Timber Maze
- Splash Island first level (Family and Toddler slide)

#### **ACCESS CATEGORY 3:**

Attractions in this category have no wheelchair access with multiple steps or stairways and multi-level surfaces. Access and egress to this attraction is difficult, even with specific companion assistance. There are many physically limiting rider requirements stipulated by Outback Splash, or the Manufacturer of the attraction that cannot be overcome by companion assistance.
